THE MINING (MINERALS AND MINERAL CONCENTRATES TRADING) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 2026

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Mining (Minerals and Mineral Concentrates Trading) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026, and shall be read together with the Mining (Minerals and Mineral Concentrates Trading) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

Addition of
regulations
13H and 13I

2. The principal Regulations are amended by adding immediately after regulation 13G the following:

““Royalty and
inspection fee

13H.-(1) A holder of a mineral right, broker licence, dealer licence or temporary permit for industrial minerals and building minerals shall-

- (a) pay royalty and inspection fee for minerals produced before sale or consumption; and
 - (b) declare minerals produced by using form MTF 23 specified in the Second Schedule before paying royalty and inspection fee.
- (2) An authorised officer shall-
- (a) calculate the amount of royalty and inspection fee and issue a control number after the declaration of minerals; and

- (b) activate a POS machine to allow sale or consumption of minerals after payment of royalty and inspection fee.

Undeproduction

13I. Where a holder of a mineral right, broker licence, dealer licence or temporary permit for industrial minerals and building materials fails to meet the declared production volume due to underproduction, and has paid royalty and inspection fee, the excess amount paid shall be carried forward to the next production period.”.

Amendment of Second Schedule

3. The principal Regulations are amended in the Second Schedule by adding immediately after Form. MTF. 22 the following:
